In continuation of the allocation plan of Remdesivir drug for the period 21<sup>st</sup> April to 9<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 communicated by DO issued on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 an updated allocation plan valid for the period 21<sup>st</sup> April to 16<sup>th</sup> May, 2021, prepared jointly by Department of Pharmaceuticals and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, is annexed. The company-state supply plan will be communicated in due course. It is reiterated that :

- (i) The allotment is being made for the States/UTs, and it is the State Governments and UTs that have to monitor proper distribution within the State/ UT, covering government and private hospitals as appropriate and in line with judicious use.
- (ii) State Governments/UTs are advised to place adequate purchase orders with the marketing companies immediately, if they have not already done so, for the quantity that they want to purchase out of the allocation for the State /UT as per supply plan in close coordination with the liaison officers of the companies. The coordination with private distribution channel in the state could also be made.

(iii) Nodal officers of the State Governments have to coordinate and follow up with the marketing companies to get delivery of Remdesivir injection in time as per the daily requirements.
