

## Marginal fall in Zydus Cadila's profit in March quarter

Healthcare player Cadila Healthcare (Zydus Cadila) posted standalone net profit of ₹338 crore for the quarter ended March 2016, which is marginally down by 2 per cent from ₹347 crore in the corresponding quarter a year ago.

The company's standalone income from operations stood at ₹1,429 crore for the quarter against ₹1,454 crore in the same period last year.

For the full year, the company's net profit on standalone basis stood at ₹1,977 crore, which is 55 per cent higher than ₹1,271 crore last year. Total income stood at ₹7,035 crore for the year under review, against ₹5,284 crore last year.

On a consolidated basis, net

profit for the quarter ended March 2016, stood at ₹389 crore, up 11 per cent, from ₹350 crore in the corresponding quarter last year.

Total consolidated income for the quarter stood at ₹2,449 crore against ₹2,288 crore last year.

Cadila Healthcare shares fell by over 2 per cent on Friday to close at ₹326.10 on the NSE.
