

Lupin gets US FDA approval for selling diarrhoea drug

Lupin has received approval from the US health regulator to sell a generic version of Vancocin capsules, used in treating diarrhoea, in the American market. The company has received final approval for its Vancomycin Hydrochloride Capsules in strengths of 125 mg and 250 mg from the US Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) to market a generic version of ANI Pharmaceuticals, Inc's Vancocin. As per the IMS MAT September, 2014 sales data, Vancocin capsules had annual US sales of \$164.2 million.
