

■ Govt Exempts AIDS Drugs from Customs Duty



NEW DELHI Government on

Wednesday exempted a host of drugs, diagnostics and medical equipments used in treatment of

AIDS from customs duty to make them cheaper. The exemption will be in effect till March 31, 2016, said a notification issued by the Central Board of Excise and Customs. Additional duty on such imports has also been waived. The exemption will benefit Anti-Retroviral Drugs (ARV Drugs) – Adult First Line, Adult Second Line and Paediatric Drugs.
