

**Venus Remedies up 15.5%
on tie-up with Israel's Teva**

Mumbai: Shares of Venus Remedies surged over 15.5% on Wednesday as the company entered into a collaborative agreement with Israel-based generic drug maker Teva for selling an anti-cancer drug in the Canadian market. The pharma firm's scrip soared 14.77% to settle at Rs 295.65 on the BSE. At the NSE, it climbed 15.52% to close at Rs 296.30. — PTI
