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Strides gets USFDA nod for generic anti-anxiety tablets

BANGALORE: Strides Arcolab has received United States Food and Drug Administration (USFDA) approval for Buspirone Hydrochloride tablets USP, 5 mg, 10 mg, 15 mg and 30 mg. The company said the product would be manufactured at its oral dosage facility here. Buspirone tablets are used for treatment of anxiety disorders and the short-term relief of the symptoms of anxiety. Strides will be marketing it directly in the U.S., a release said. The U.S. market for generic Buspirone tablets, as on September, 2013, was about \$65 million. —
